

Researcher (TV-L 13, 10h/week) in law

The Center for Interdisciplinary Labour Law Studies (C*LLaS) is a vibrant hub for academic research about law, labour and society at the European University Viadrina in Frankfurt (Oder). Our goal is to inform current public and academic debates by producing high-quality legal research grounded in theory and empirical data.

We are looking to hire a legal academic from October/November 2024 to September/October 2026 (2 years) in the context of the German-Ukrainian project “Just Transition”.

The project aims to develop proposals for Ukrainian (post-)war labour law. It starts from the assumption that the protection of workers and the promotion of social dialogue must be important factors for the development of Ukraine in the coming post-war period. To this end, a team from C*LLaS/Viadrina will work together with a team from the Ukrainian National University Kiyv-Mohyla-Akademy (NaUKMA) to develop options for the development of labour law in Ukraine, taking particular account of ECHR and EU law.

About the position

Your tasks will include:

- academic coordination of the joint work of EUV and NaUKMA teams on Ukrainian labour law.
- research on the requirements of ECHR and EU law and participation in the joint German-Ukrainian academic debate.
- continuous scientific communication of the project to the public; coordination of social media communication.
- internal coordination of the team at C*LLaS, including coordination of organisation and administration of the project; continuous communication with Ukrainian partners as well as partners at Viadrina; preparation and implementation of meetings.

Job requirements:

- You have an above-average degree in law or a degree with a focus on law (at least a Master's degree)
- You have experience in managing projects in academia or other fields and leadership skills;
- You have excellent writing skills in English as well as decent knowledge of German;
- You are a good team worker (and have, preferably, experience in teamwork).

What we offer:

- 25% position of “Akademische Mitarbeiter*in” for 10h/week;
- Salary of 13 TV-L, according to Brandenburg regulations;

- Collaboration with an German-Ukrainian team of researchers and partners;
- Workplace at an international university, in Frankfurt (Oder);
- Excellent academic development opportunities.
